V. PRESENTATION

- a. Davidson Police Department North Carolina Law Enforcement Accreditation (NCLEA)**
Presenter: Philip Geiger, Police Chief/Assistant Town Manager
Summary: The Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards Commission and the Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission approved the North Carolina Law Enforcement Accreditation (NCLEA) program in June 2023. Accreditation through NCLEA is voluntary for law enforcement agencies in North Carolina. There are currently 116 standards that require compliance. There is no fee for participation. The Davidson Police Department received its initial accreditation with NCLEA on August 14, 2026, during the Criminal Justice Commission Meeting.

b. Metropolitan Public Transportation Authority (MPTA) Update from Davidson MPTA Trustee Matt Walt & Brian Nadolny (CATS)

Summary: Approval of the PAVE Act earlier this year established the Metropolitan Public Transportation Authority (MPTA), charged with expanding and modernizing the region's transit infrastructure, improving connectivity, and increasing mobility options for residents and visitors across Mecklenburg County. The MPTA will be responsible for implementing the approved CATS 2055 Transit System Plan, including bus, rail (including Red Line commuter rail), and Microtransit expansion and enhancements.

The authority is led by a 27-member board that includes representatives from across the county. Davidson's Trustee Matt Walt will provide an update on MPTA's activities to date and workplan in the near term.

Summary: The Board of Commissioners will discuss the upcoming Charlotte Regional Transportation Planning Organization (CRTPO) vote regarding the I-77 South toll lane project. The Board will consider the project's potential impacts on Davidson, including the implications of the state budget penalty associated with the project and related funding and transportation priorities. At its September 22 meeting, the Board of Commissioners will vote on its direction to Mayor Knox regarding how Davidson should be represented in the upcoming CRTPO vote.
